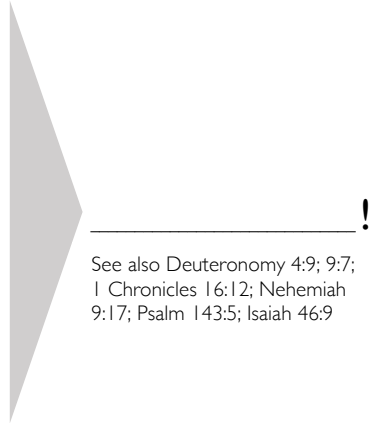

5. What is the most important lesson you learned from this week’s message? How are you going to make sure you remember it?

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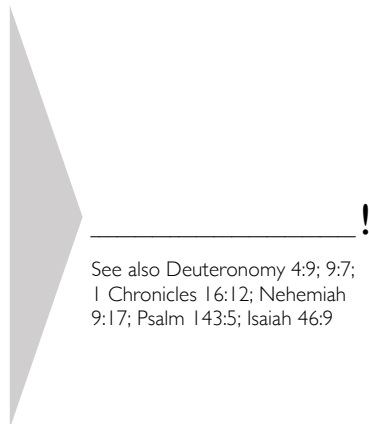
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
