Questions for Reflection & Discussion

1. How long have you been praying for that which you put in the box on your note sheet? Do you think you are still trusting God to answer that prayer? Why or why not?
2. Look up and read the following passages out loud: Genesis 18:14; Jeremiah 32:17; Jeremiah 32:27; Matthew 19:26; Mark 14:36; Luke 1:37; and Ephesians 3:20-21. How does the truth that these passages teach apply to the deepest desire of your heart?
3. Read Matthew 17:24, Mark 9:23, Hebrews 11:6 and James 1:6-7. Do you think your faith, or lack of faith, affects how powerfully God works in your life? When have you seen faith or unbelief make a difference in your prayers?
4. Read 1 John 5:14-15 and Luke 1:37 (in the New International Version). Are you sure that what you wrote in your box is God’s will? How do you know? If you are not sure it is His will, how could your prayer evolve to be in sync with what you know to be His will?
5. Read Luke 11:5-10 and Luke 18:1-8. Do you think that continuing to plead with God to do what He has not yet done demonstrates faith or a lack of submission to His will?
