### Questions for Reflection & Discussion

1. Read Luke 7:36-50. What does the depth of your love for Jesus reveal about your self-awareness?

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2. Read Luke 8:4-8 and Proverbs 2:1-5. When you read or listen to something in the Bible that is confusing, what do you typically do? What are some ways you could seek clarification?

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3. Read Luke 8:11-12. Who, among non-Christians you know and love, do you most want to be with you in heaven? Take time (right now!) to pray for that person's salvation. If they have not heard the gospel, how can you make sure they do?

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**4.** Read Luke 8:13-14. Among the dangers Jesus mentions in these verses, what are you most susceptible to? How can you keep your spiritual life free from that thorny weed?

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**5.** Read Luke 6:46-49 and Luke 8:19-21. Do you think obedience is optional for Christians? Why or why not? In what area of your life is the Spirit of God nudging you to obey the word of God right now?

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
