2. Read Mark 14:55-64. Why do you think Jesus was silent when he could have defended Himself? And why did He speak when He knew it would get Him into trouble?

3. Read Luke 22:51, 23:34 and 23:43. What do these verses reveal about Jesus? What lesson is there in them for those who want to be more like Jesus?

4. Read Luke 23:34; Luke 23:43; John 19:26-27; Mark 15:34; John 19:28; John 19:30; and Luke 23:46. Which of these seven statements on the cross is most meaningful to you? Why?

5. Have you ever read Matthew 27, Mark 15, Luke 23 and John 19 side-by-side? What unique contribution does each Gospel writer make to the story of Christ's death?
