Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 (NLT): Two people are better off than one, for they can help each other succeed. **10** If one person falls, the other can reach out and help. But someone who falls alone is in real trouble. **11** Likewise, two people lying close together can keep each other warm. But how can one be warm alone? **12** A person standing alone can be attacked and defeated, but two can stand back-to-back and conquer. Three are even better, for a triple-braided cord is not easily broken.

Acts 2:42, 46: They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship , to the breaking of bread and to prayer 46 Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts
Philemon 6 (NIV84): I pray that you may be active in sharing your faith, so that you will have a full understanding of every good thing we have in Christ.

Hebrews 10:24-25: And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, 25 not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

Hebrews 3:12-14: See to it, brothers and sisters, that none of you has a sinful, unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God. 13 But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called "Today," so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness. 14 We have come to share in Christ, if indeed we hold our original conviction firmly to the very end.

Romans 12:16: Live in harmony with one another.

James 5:16: ...Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed.

1 John 3:18: Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth (see also Romans 12:10; 13:8; 1 Thessalonians 4:9; Hebrews 13:1; 1 Peter 1:22; 3:8; 4:8-9; 1 John 3:11, 23; 4:7, 11; 2 John 5).
