3. Read 1 Peter 4:10. What is your primary spiritual gift? Are you using it faithfully right now? Is it easy or hard for you to do? Why?
4. Read Matthew 28:19-20 and 1 Peter 3:15. Do you think you have been faithful in sharing your faith? What would it look like for you to be more faithful in evangelism?
5. Read 2 Chronicles 7:17-18. In what area of your life are you more faithful to God's word than you were a year ago? In what area are you less faithful than you were a year ago? Overall, how would you grade your faithfulness? Why?
