Questions for Reflection & Discussion

1. If someone were to ask you, before Sunday's message, how to live forever, what would your answer have been?

2. Read Matthew 13:40-43, 47-50. Based on these verses, what is required for entrance into heaven?

3. Read Matthew 19:14-26. Why do you think Matthew, Mark and Luke all told the stories of Jesus' interaction with children and with the rich young ruler back-to-back? What was it about childlikeness that the rich young ruler lacked?

4. Read John 3:16-18 and John 11:25-26, then read John 5:28-29 and John 8:51. How do you reconcile these seemingly different paths to salvation?

5. Did you learn anything new from this week's message, or were your prior beliefs about salvation affirmed? What tension must be maintained to encompass everything Jesus taught about salvation?
