Questions for Reflection and Discussion

1. How have the cultural changes in sexuality that have taken place since you first began to follow Jesus affected your faith and theology?
2. Read Matthew 10:2-9. What is the significance of Christ's appeal to Genesis 1:27 and Genesis 2:4 in the debate about sexuality? What do they reveal about sex that is relevant in 2022?
3. Read Matthew 5:17-19 and Leviticus 18:6-23. Is it true that Jesus did not express his opinion about sexuality? What do these passages reveal about His perspective?
4. Read Matthew 15:19. What Old and New Testament passages help define "sexual immorality"?
5. Read John 8:3-11. What does Christ's interaction with the woman caught in adultery teach us about how to relate to those whose sexuality we consider sinful? What does His interaction with the accusers teach us about ourselves?
