Questions for Reflection & Discussion

1. Has there been a time in your life when you can remember deciding to believe in Jesus? If so, in what sense is your life different now than it was before you made that decision? If not, what gives you assurance that Christ is at work in your life?
2. Read John 8:31-36 and Romans 6:1-11. In what aspects of your life do you feel you have been set free from sin? In what aspects is it still a daily battle? How are you fighting to live in the freedom Jesus died to give you?
3. Read Romans 7:1-6 and Romans 8:1-4. What role did God's law play in your life before you were a Christian? What role does it play in your life as a Christian?
4. Read 2 Corinthians 5:14-15 and Galatians 2:19-20. Do you believe that living for Jesus is more fulfilling than living for yourself? If not, why are you skeptical? If so, in what ways have you experienced joy as a Jesus-follower?
5. How did the Spirit of God speak to you personally during Sunday's message? How are you responding to His voice?
