4. Read Acts 1:8 and Acts 8:1-4. What strategy do you see when you compare these two passages side-by-side?
5. Who in your relational network has the Spirit of God nudged you to share your faith with? Do you think an invitation to White Pine's Easter service is a good way to do that? If so, how will you invite them?
