Questions for Reflection & Discussion

1. What did you know about Samson before Sunday's message? What didn't you know about him that you now know?
2. Read Judges 13:5 and 13:25. Do you believe the Spirit of the Lord stirs in you and that you have a special calling from God? What passages in the New Testament help you to answer this question?
3. Read Deuteronomy 7:3-4 and 2 Corinthians 6:14. What are the dangers of being "unequally yoked" to a non-Christian? If you are married to a non-Christian, how have you learned to retain your devotion to God?
4. Compare Judges 13:25, 14:6, 14:19, 15:14 and 16:20. What changed? What is the lesson in Judges 16:20 for you?
5. Read Judges 16:22-30. How can you repair the holes in your God-tank so that you can maximize the potential you have to be used by God in the remaining years of your life?
