4. Read Luke 22:60-62. What has been your most regrettable failure? Based on Luke 22:32 and John 21:15-17, how do you think Jesus sees that failure differently than you do?
5. Read 1 Corinthians 12:27. How do you think seeing others with the eyes of Christ might change your life? Begin each of the next three days by offering your eyes to God as instruments of righteousness.
