1. Read Luke 7:36-50. When you hear or read the words, “Your sins are forgiven”, what is your emotional reaction? Why?
2. Read Numbers 15:28-31. What would it be like for you to live with the possibility that only your unintentional sins could be forgiven?
3. Read Jeremiah 31:31-34. How do you think this prophecy affected those who had lived under the old covenant of the Mosaic law? What was radical about it?
4. Read Acts 13:38-39 and Hebrews 10:10. Do these passages assure *you* that you have been forgiven? Why or why not?
5. Read 1 John 1:8—2:2. Why do you think some people are reluctant to confess their sins? What are the benefits of doing so?
